Nora Radu is Technical Fellow in the Electronics and Industrial business at DuPont. She joined DuPont in 1998. During most of her career at DuPont, her research has focused to advance the performance of materials in use in OLED displays for consumer electronics, and to develop novel colorless polyimide films that will enable the next generation of durable, flexible displays for cell phones and tablets. Dr. Radu is an inventor on over 60 granted patents. She was awarded the Pedersen Medal and is a Fellow of the ACS. She has served as the ACS Division of Inorganic Chemistry program co-chair is the currently the division's chair-elect.

Dr. Radu received a Ph.D. in Inorganic Chemistry from University of California, San Diego and her B.S. in Chemistry from Ithaca College. Prior to joining DuPont, she was a NIH postdoctoral fellow at MIT.
